1. County Attorney Neil Yarbough handed out information and discussed the Fair Labor Standards Act for fire departments. Mr. Yarbough advised the association that all fire departments of Cumberland County did apply to this Act.
2. Freddy Johnson announced that Chief Mike Middleton would be serving as Chairman of the bulk purchasing committee, any department wishing to purchase equipment under the bulk rate, contact Mike Middleton at Lafayette Village F.D. (425-2207)

#### NEW BUSINESS:

1. President Johnson announced that Chief Allen Cain of the Cumberland Road F.D. would be serving as the new Chairman for the Education Committee.
2. Gearld Bloom presented an Officer I training program. There was some discussion concerning this program.
3. Doug McKenney, President of the Firefighters Association announced classes that would be available to firefighters in the county beginning January 1989.
4. Al Rozier with Vander Fire Department advised the association that he was willing to provide funding to purchase advertisement to begin a water system for Cumberland County. A motion was made by Freddy Johnson and second by Mike Middleton to appoint a committee to begin this project.
5. Dan Eberhardt gave information concerning a local paper advertising the emergency number as 484-1111. This problem will be taken care of.
6. Benny Nichols, CERT Commander advised that the city would be preparing the budget now for the counties cert team instead of the county. Benny also advised that the response of the team would remain as it always has been.
7. Fire Marshal Koonce advised that the paper work had been mailed to Raleigh to have ISO come and inspect the Godwin/Falcon F.D. for a municipal rating.
8. Fire Marshal Koonce advised that any member of a fire department that has retired and is drawing their pension could now go back and serve as a member of their F.D. But will not be able to receive any death benefit money while performing this duty.
9. Fire Marshal Koonce advised that our local legislators had approved money to be given to some local fire departments of Cumberland County.
10. Fire Marshal Koonce introduced the new Chief of the Raeford Road F.D. Roy Duke Jr.
11. Chief Mike Middleton advised the association that if any departments were interested in purchasing the white reflective letters to identify their vehicles to contact him and he would give the information were they could be purchased.
12. President Johnson made a motion to have the association to purchase a plaque and present it to retired Chief Roy Duke at the next meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
